They Went to California!

In the course of snooping around research sites, I came up with some exciting new information. **The Nevada County, California GenWeb Site** had transcribed The Nevada County Business & Residential Directory for 1856. Among others, it listed my second great grandfather, Waters Nathan WAITE and two other men whom I've been able to identify as Benjamin Case WAITE and Edwin Giles WAITE; both descendants of Thomas of Portsmouth. Might there be a connection with Waters? Even if there is no connection, I've still closed the eight year gap between the 1860 California census and the 1852 dismissal from the Congregational Church in Cornwall, VT by half. It is beginning to look like he may have gone directly to California. Please, if you can provide any new information on any of these three men...or can submit a WAITE line that moved to California prior to 1870...please submit your information. It'll certainly help me and may well help other researchers with "wandering WAITES" in their background. These three men were listed as follows:
