

## WAIT(E)S Line #2 of Culpeper County

We don't always get the result we expected when engaging in genetic genealogy. Sometimes the answer is more questions.

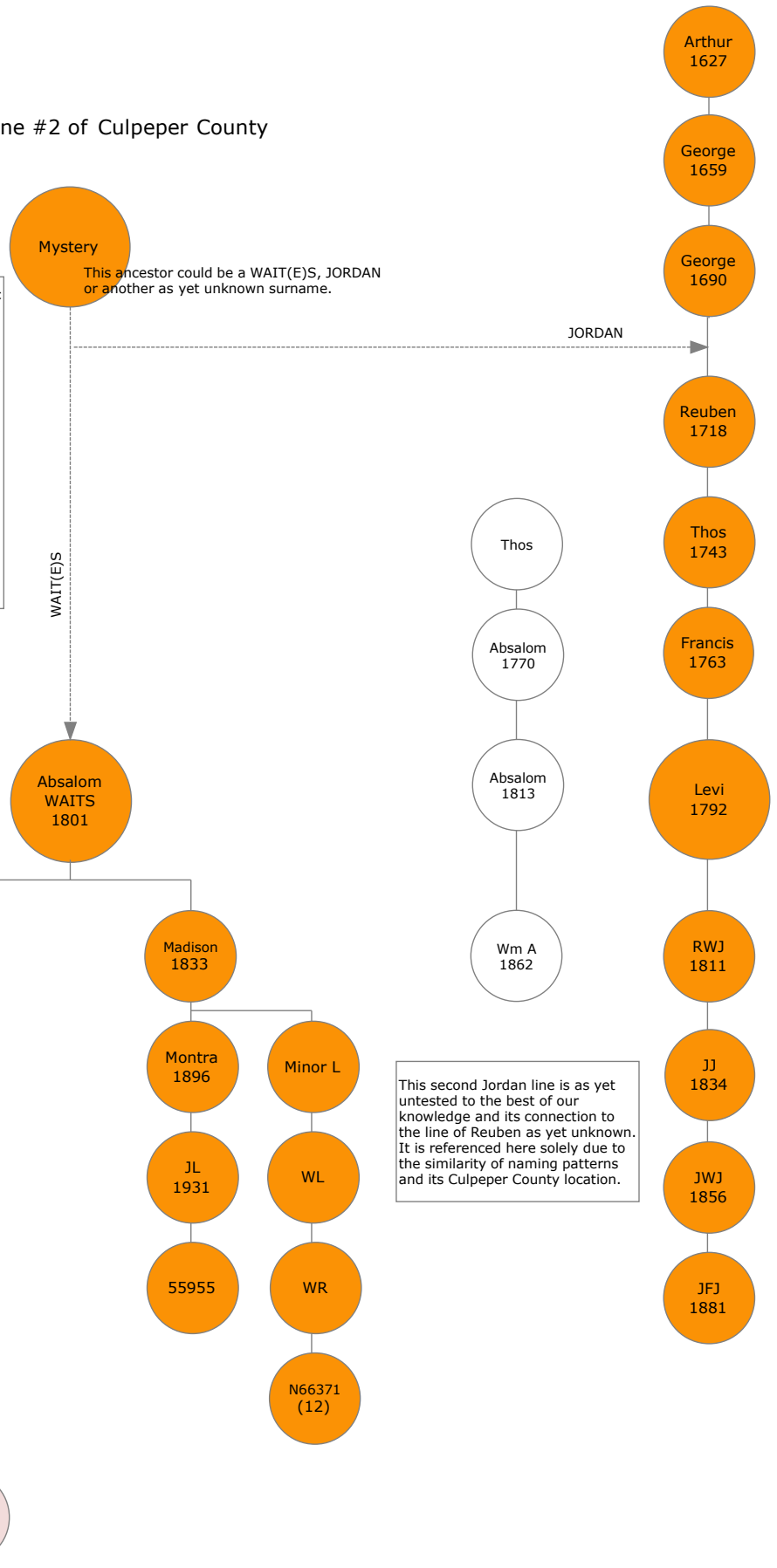
The Wait(e)s line shown on the left was expected to match the Culpeper family. It does not! Nor, does this genetic signature match any of the previously identified signatures for the surname Wait(e) or any of its variant spellings.

What is DOES match is a 47-marker signature for a man surnamed Jordan that was found in the SMGF database.

Ordinarily we wouldn't pay too much attention to a match with a different surname. However, in this case the Jordan subject has roots in Culpeper County as well.

Because these families are located in the same county at the same time, there is a distinct possibility of an old NPE.

Research needs to be done on this Jordan line to determine where a NPE might have occurred and in which line it did occur.



This second Jordan line is as yet untested to the best of our knowledge and its connection to the line of Reuben as yet unknown. It is referenced here solely due to the similarity of naming patterns and its Culpeper County location.
