About 1840 he removed to Loraine Co., OH. (WHIT)

I haven't been able to ascertain who his parents were, but I suspect it was a Thomas Wait, from New York who moved to what was to become Lorain Co., S. Amherst area, in 1817. (DEB)

Harrison Wait(e) was not very well liked in the S. Amherst community. According to pension records for his first son, Harrison had a difficult time keeping a job, would disappear for weeks and months, was abusive to his wife, etc. From descriptions, I think he had a hernia and what sounds like a stroke in the 1860's, shortly after his first son, John, died from a disease contracted at camp during the Civil War. Also, right after John died, 2 of Harrison's daughters died. But, still, the babies kept coming. The older kids were begging for food from the neighbors. Martha Ellen and the 2 youngest kids ended up in the poorhouse around 1876 for a few months. Maybe this is why I can't find any familial connection to
